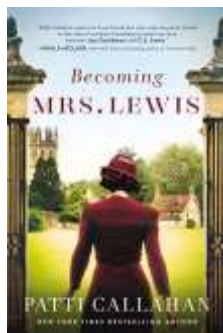

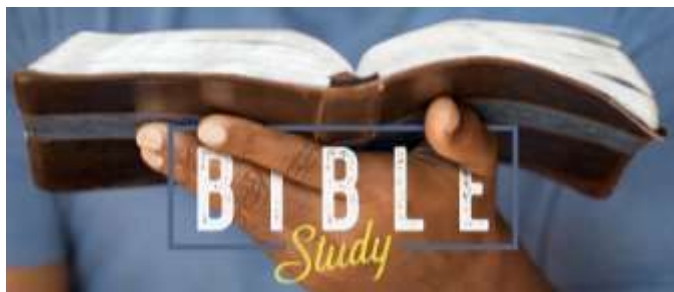

- How your church can protect its religious freedom as it seeks to operate according to biblical principles

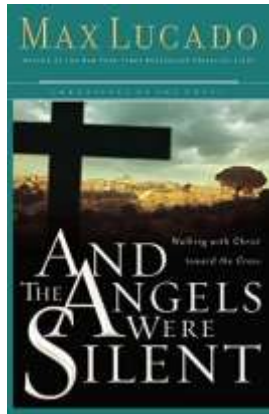

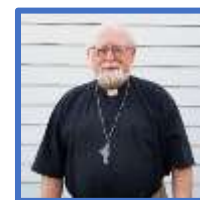
