

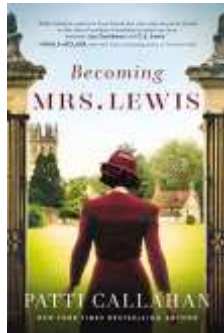

THE WOODBURY CHORUS ORCHESTRA presents "The Gift of Music" today **Sunday, March 26th** at 4:00 pm at St.

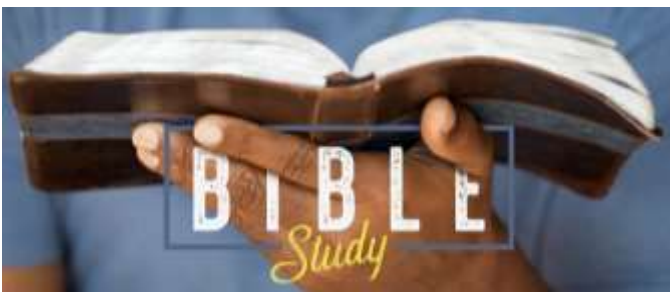
Paul's Lutheran Church in Prior Lake. "A concert of uplifting choral and orchestral music in a variety

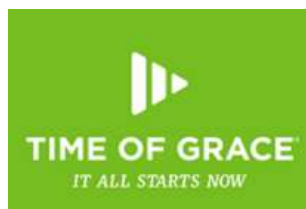
ADULT BIBLE STUDY Join us at 10:15 after the church service. Feel free to get a cup of coffee first and snack before we start.

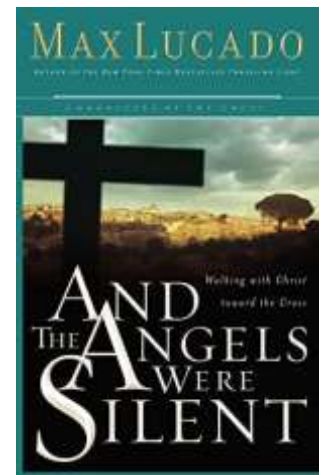
